Why Indiana BMV Paperwork Causes Confusion

Many drivers assume that an SR-22 and an SR-50 are the same thing, but under Indiana law, they serve two distinct purposes:

- 1. The SR-50 (Affidavit of Current Insurance):** This form looks backward. It is used to prove to the BMV that you had active liability insurance on the specific date of an incident, such as a traffic stop or an accident. If you had valid coverage at that time, submitting an SR-50 can often clear a pending suspension without further penalties.
- 2. The SR-22 (Certificate of Financial Responsibility):** This form looks forward. It is a formal certificate that your insurance company files directly with the Indiana BMV. It guarantees that you will maintain continuous liability insurance for a mandatory period—typically three years. If the policy lapses or is canceled during this window, the insurer is legally required to notify the state, resulting in an immediate license suspension.

Avoiding Costly Mistakes

A lack of clear information often causes drivers to make preventable errors. Some buy expensive policies they do not need, while others let a policy lapse for a few days, accidentally resetting their three-year SR-22 requirement back to day one.

Furthermore, drivers who do not own a vehicle often do not realize that a "non-owner SR-22 policy" exists, which allows them to fulfill BMV requirements at a fraction of the cost.
