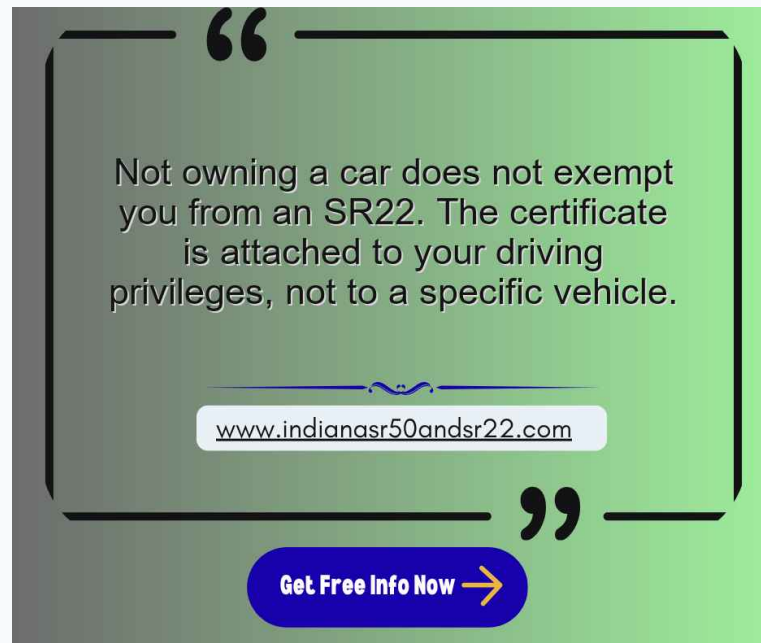


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"I sold the car, so the SR22 goes away, right

It doesn't. Not owning a vehicle doesn't exempt you — the certificate is attached to your driving privileges, not to a specific car.

The mental model that helps: picture it clipped to your licence, not parked in your driveway.

Once it sits in the right place in your head, the rest of the process stops feeling arbitrary.
